School Break on the Plains Winter activities for the whole family!



Québec, February 21, 2014 – During school break, the National Battlefields Commission has a week full of activities for you at little or no cost on the Plains of Abraham. With the Snowshoer Family Outing, Odyssey multimedia exhibition, foot rally, plus cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and skating, there's something for the whole family!

Snowshoer Family Outing

Pull on your tuques, mitts, sashes, and traditional snowshoes and relive the winters of bygone days with this fascinating



snowshoe outing on the Plains. Travel back to another time with our storyteller, who will explain how people got through winter in the early 20th century. You'll learn about things like making the famous ointment used to prevent frostbite and hear other tips and anecdotes as you travel between stops and stations along the way.

The activity starts at the Discovery Pavilion with a brief introduction. Actual snowshoeing lasts about 60 minutes and ends with a story over a nice cup of hot chocolate!

Make a virtual journey 400 years back in time through the magic of multimedia. Follow in the footsteps of the first European explorers, dive into the heart of the conflict that led from the French dream to the British occupation, and witness the very founding of the country.

Cross-country Skiing, Snowshoeing, and Skating free



Enjoy winter sports for free at a captivating and accessible site and admire dazzling views of the St. Lawrence River. Skate around the ice oval on the Plains of Abraham, ski the beginner and intermediate groomed cross-country trails (12.6 km), go snowshoeing (3.8 km return), or enjoy a nice walk (5.6 km). A waxing room, two heated shelters, and a skaters' chalet are also at your disposal.
